Go Tell It on the Mountain (ELW 290, vs. 1)

HOLY GOSPEL Matthew 2:1-12

P: The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew.

C: Glory to you, O Lord.

¹ In the time of King Herod, after Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, wise men from the East came to Jerusalem, ² asking, "Where is the child who has been born king of the Jews? For we observed his star at its rising, and have come to pay him homage." ³ When King Herod heard this, he was frightened, and all Jerusalem with him; ⁴ and calling together all the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. ⁵ They told him, "In Bethlehem of Judea; for so it has been written by the prophet: ⁶ 'And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for from you shall come a ruler who is to shepherd my people Israel.'" ⁷ Then Herod secretly called for the wise men and learned from them the exact time when the star had appeared. ⁸ Then he sent them to Bethlehem, saying, "Go and search diligently for the child; and when you have found him, bring me word so that I may also go and pay him homage." ⁹ When they had heard the king, they set out; and there, ahead of them, went the star that they had seen at its rising, until it stopped over the place where the child was. ¹⁰ When they saw that the star had stopped, they were overwhelmed with joy. ¹¹ On

entering the house, they saw the child with Mary his mother; and they knelt down and paid him homage. Then, opening their treasure chests, they offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. ¹² And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they left for their own country by another road.



Crown of Glory RIC Statement Survey: submit your input by January 13, 2025

The Justice and Inclusion Team has been faithfully leading Crown of Glory through the process of becoming a Reconciling in Christ (RIC) congregation (https://www.reconcilingworks.org/) over the past two years. The next step in the process is to draft and adopt an RIC Statement that will be published throughout Crown of Glory (website, bulletins, building, etc.) as a public declaration of who we aspire to be as a community of faith and our commitment to welcoming everyone.

The J&I Team has drafted an RIC Statement and is thrilled to share it with the Crown of Glory community to receive feedback on whether you think this is a statement that fits who Crown of Glory is becoming in faith together.

Each member of Crown of Glory is welcome to complete this survey (no age limit); it is anonymous and no emails or names will be collected. Once the J&I Team has received feedback, the goal is to present this statement at the Annual Meeting on February 9, 2025 and move for an official congregational vote to adopt this RIC statement and become a Reconciling in Christ congregation (welcoming and accepting of all people, race, cultures, ethnicities, genders, and sexual orientations).


Crown of Glory's Monthly Pledge to the Bountiful Basket Food Shelf


