

#### A Long Time Coming!

At long last, the summer has arrived, and the Holy Spirit is alive and moving at Crown of Glory! Our program year for ministries may be drawing to a close, but we are getting ready to move with the Spirit into a summer that is packed with opportunities and adventure for everyone to enjoy. I invite you to take part in all the summertime activities, events, and Spirit-filled experiences over the next several months.

#### Summer Worship

Our worship will have a new look to it this summer. After a very strong response from our Summer Worship Survey, we are once again temporarily moving our Saturday Evening Worship service to Wednesday nights for the summer season with a brand-new start time of 6:00 p.m. The service itself will retain much of the same format and feel of an "Evening Prayer" style of worship. #### Vacation Bible School

For the first time in a few years, we are not able to provide Vacation Bible School for our little ones this summer. Our leadership position is currently vacant as we seek to call and hire a new Director of SPARK Ministry over the summer. Please keep our Children's Ministry Search Team and their work in your prayers as we conduct our search this summer! #### Stewardship and Finances

We are staying the course with our stewardship and gifts moving into the summer. Be sure to review the Finance Corner in this edition of the *Crownicle*. Finally, we give thanks that our congregation approved the refinancing of our Mortgage with our partner Bank Vista on April 28! #### Dear Friends in Christ,

Summer is upon us and in the liturgical calendar that means it is time to celebrate Pentecost and lean into the Time after Pentecost, or "Ordinary Time."

On Pentecost (May 18-19), we celebrated the arrival of the Holy Spirit among God's people, creating a diversity of languages, colors, and cultures. This holy, breezy, windy Spirit remains with us today and inspires our faithful living. The Sanctuary was transformed with symbols of the Spirit: holy, living fire in bright red, orange, gold, and pure white doves, descending over the baptismal font, reminding us of the promise we all claim in God's love.

May 26 and 29 will begin our summer worship schedule, with Sunday worship at 9:00 a.m. and Wednesday worship at 6:00 p.m. Be sure to watch your weekly Crownicle eNewsletter for "Evening on the Patio" fellowship opportunities that will immediately follow Wednesday worship, sponsored by the Council and various ministry teams throughout the summer season!

Summer worship will also mark the beginning of our Time after Pentecost, or "Ordinary Time," where the Sanctuary is filled with a variety of greens and we celebrate the fullness of life in God, in faith, and in life with one another, friends, and family. This summer will be divided into two worship themes: God's Healing in Jesus and the Bread of Life. As we begin the summer, we will hear several accounts from the Gospel of Mark of Jesus' miracles that often involved healing and bringing about wholeness through faith. The last five weeks of summer, we will switch to the Gospel of John and hear the many descriptions from Jesus of how he is the Bread of Life, sustaining us in our lives and nurturing us in our faith.

Be sure to watch the Crown of Glory patio throughout the summer, as our Worship Arts Team will be planting wheat in pots labeled, "The Future Bread of Life," and the full-grown wheat will eventually adorn our worship space as we transition from the Gospel of Mark to the Gospel of John.

A big thank-you to our Worship Arts Team, as they make one final push to prepare the Sanctuary for the summer season before taking a well-deserved few months off. Their inspiration, creativity, and passion for bringing themes and Scripture to life in worship has been absolutely fabulous and I cannot wait to see what they come up with in the 2024-2025 program year!

I also want to lift up the AV Team, Worship Assistants, and Hospitality Team and offer my gratitude for all the ways they led, supported, and provided for our worship life this past year. Thanks to all of you that attended the 2024 Annual Meeting! Attendees approved a budget that calls for total revenue of \$726,504, total expenses (operating, other expenditures) of \$722,602, and a net of \$3,902. Through March 2024, revenues are ahead of budget by \$8,549, expenses are ahead of budget \$522, which results in a net that is \$9,071 ahead of budget. If we focus on contributions, it shows that \$139,500 was budgeted and \$142,635 has been received to date, with net contributions \$3,135 ahead of budget. This is great to see! As we head into summer, we encourage you to join us in keeping net contributions ahead of budget.

A couple of key items discussed at the Annual Meeting were a mortgage rate adjustment in November and the status of member loans with a total \$203,500. While members have graciously rolled these loans over from one year to the next, the Finance Team has been concerned about the impact on Crown of Glory's financial situation if a sizeable portion of these loans needed to be repaid at one time. Our mortgage holder, Bank Vista, was approached to discuss options for doing the rate adjustment and addressing the member loans. Bank Vista responded with a proposal to modify the existing mortgage to fix the mortgage rate at 7% for the remainder of the loan, change the amortization period from 20 to 25 years, reduce the monthly payment amount by roughly \$1,000, and offer a net proceed to Crown of Glory of roughly \$215,000. This proposal comes with the stipulation that member loans must be paid off. The Finance Team and Executive Council jointly reviewed the offer and recommended the proposal be accepted. The full Council voted to proceed with accepting the proposal. A special congregation meeting was scheduled for April 28, 2024, required notices sent, the meeting was held, and the congregation unanimously approved moving forward with the proposal. The mortgage modification is expected to be closed by the end of May 2024 and all remaining member loans will be repaid once the net proceeds are received by Crown of Glory.

Now that the mortgage rate adjustment and member loans have been addressed, what does that mean? It means that Crown of Glory is in a position to move forward with hiring a part-time SPARK Director. It also means Crown of Glory can start formulating plans to complete the parking lot and finish the kitchen! There is also the potential to partner with Bank Vista to make the lower level of the education wing usable and an additional revenue source. With so many possibilities on the horizon, we give thanks for all the ways God has provided for Crown of Glory, and for your faithful support.

#### Crown of Glory – My "Home" Church

When I think about my "home" church, I hear the theme song from the '80s TV sitcom *Cheers* playing in my head:

"Sometimes you want to go, where everybody knows your name. And they're always glad you came. You want to be where everybody knows your name."

Growing up, I had a "home" church. It was a wonderful place where I attended Sunday School, took first communion, got confirmed, sang in the choir, and participated in many Christmas narratives. I knew everyone, and they knew me. It was like my second home and an extension of my family.

When my family and I became members of Crown of Glory in 2016, we chose it because of the ministries that were offered, specifically for children and music. We felt this would be a good place to build relationships and create a "home" church. I wanted my girls to have the same experience growing up as I did; however, creating a "home" church doesn't happen quickly. It takes a lot of time and effort to make connections and build relationships, and I know I will only get out of it what I put into it. If I only want a place to worship once a week and send my kids to Sunday School and Confirmation, then that's all I should expect out of my home church. But, if I want a place that's more than that, I need to get involved and put in the work to achieve that outcome. So I joined the Chancel Choir and Chancel Chimers and helped with SPARK. I really started to feel like this was my home church. But, in 2020, a global pandemic hit and put an abrupt stop to the momentum I had going. Being shut down and disconnected from my church was very hard. I felt like the connections I had established were slipping away. Plus, it was hard to instill in my girls what it means to go to church if we couldn't go to church.

Once the church opened to worship in person, it just didn't feel like the home church with which I was familiar. It felt like we were new members again who had to create our home church again. It would have been easy to just walk away and find another church to attend, but we chose to stay and make Crown of Glory our home again. My girls attended SPARK and Confirmation and joined the Garage Band. I joined the Chancel Chimers and Chancel Choir again, and then I was asked to serve on the Church Council. I accepted and it opened another opportunity to get involved. It helped me reestablish some long-lost relationships and create new ones. I made new friends and was enjoying my home church again. I have developed deeper relationships with my pastors. I can reach out to them when a member of my family is having a bad week and ask them to pray for us.

Serving on Church Council is only one thing I'm involved with. I'm also on the Executive Council, Finance Committee, lead the Chancel Chimers, co-lead the Garage Band, and sing in the Chancel Choir. Last year, I helped coordinate the Church Rummage Sale. It was another opportunity to get involved and meet other members. It was a successful fundraiser for the church financially and connecting people.
